We are delighted to officially launch our Year 7 End of Year trip to Grosvenor Hall in Kent. The four day residential educational adventure activity course takes place from Friday 14 to Monday 17 July 2017.

This is the leading residential activity centre provider, welcoming over 130,000 children each year across their 10 centres. During the four days students will participate in 18 different activity sessions. The cost of the trip is currently confirmed at £140. This includes full board and accommodation, all activities and transport. Students will require a packed lunch on the Friday. In order to confirm your child's attendance on the trip we ask for a non-refundable deposit of £40 to be paid by 3 October. The instalments should be as follows:

- Deposit payment on or before 3 October 2016 - £40
- 1st payment on or before 30 November 2016 - £35
- 2nd payment on or before 28 February 2017 - £35
- 3rd and final payment on or before 28 March 2017 - £30

These payments may be made in monthly instalments to spread the cost but the instalment amount must be paid before the dates stated above and are non-refundable after those dates.

Residential courses organised by the school are an optional, but we believe they form an invaluable part of education. Students benefit hugely from the experience, both educationally and socially and I feel certain that the programme we have designed will be both enjoyable and very worthwhile.

We have now confirmed our booking and appreciate that parents and students will undoubtedly wish to find out more about this trip. We have arranged a presentation to explain more details on Thursday 29 September at 6:30pm following the Parent/Tutor meetings.

Please take into consideration that the school reserves the right to refuse to take a student on any trip if their behaviour and/or attitude within school is not acceptable. If a student is removed from this trip as a result of not meeting the school's minimum expectations then no refund will be granted.

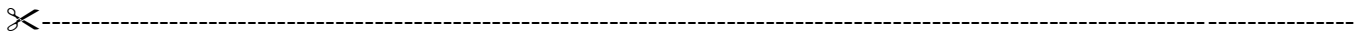
