Dear Parent or Carer

We are delighted to officially launch our Year 7 End of Year trip to Kingswood, Grosvenor Hall. The four-day residential educational adventure activity course takes place from Sunday 14 to Wednesday 17 July 2019.

This is the leading residential activity centre provider, welcoming over 130,000 children each year across their 10 centres. During the four days students will participate in 18 different activity sessions. The cost of the trip is currently confirmed at £270. This includes full board and accommodation, all activities and transport. Students will require a packed lunch on the Sunday. In order to confirm your child's attendance on the trip we ask for a non-refundable deposit of £50 to be paid by 9 November. The instalments should be as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> - Deposit payment on or before 9 November 2018 - £50

2<sup>nd</sup> payment on or before 7 December 2018 - £50

3<sup>rd</sup> payment on or before 1 February 2019 - £50

4<sup>th</sup> Payment on or before 15 March 2019 - £60

Final payment on or before 10 May - £60

These payments may be made in monthly instalments to spread the cost but the instalment amount must be paid before the dates stated above and are non-refundable after those dates.

Residential courses organised by the school are optional, but we believe they form an invaluable part of education. Students benefit hugely from the experience, both educationally and socially and I feel certain that the programme we have designed will be both enjoyable and very worthwhile.

We have now confirmed our booking of 60 places. We are pleased to say there is no upper limit to how many places are available and appreciate that parents and students will undoubtedly wish to find out more about this trip. If the confirmed places do drop below 60, please be aware that the price of the trip will probably increase. If your child is in receipt of free school meals and there may be difficulty financing the visit, please contact me at school for a discussion.

Please take into consideration that the school reserves the right to refuse to take a student on any trip if their behaviour, attendance and attitude within school is not acceptable. If a student is removed from this trip as a result of not meeting the school's minimum expectations then no refund will be granted.

If you wish to reserve a place for your child then please return the reply slip with the first payment on or before 9 November (this can be cash or cheque to Student Services). If you have any questions or concerns regarding this trip please do not hesitate to contact me at school.
