Re: Mobile Phones

I would like to draw your attention to Adeyfield School's updated mobile phone policy which can be found on our website.

Mobile phones are brought into school at the owner's risk but they cannot be on display or used in lessons or in the school building. This means students cannot have their mobile phone on display in external pockets of their blazers or shirts.

The school also asks that Parents and Carers contact the school's Reception if you need to get a message to your child.

When we return after the half term break the school will expect that all students have understood what is expected of them. Repeated failure of a student to meet the school's expectations will lead to sanctions being imposed on a student.
