Dear Parents and Carers

We write to advise you that the school day at Adeyfield will be changing from Monday 4 June. There will be no changes to our starting and finishing times, but we have reconfigured the school day slightly to enable a slightly longer lunch break for students to access clubs and activities, to extend their enrichment programme, whilst also enabling optimum opportunities for learning.
