## Spring Term Music Events 2018

Your child has been selected to perform/ take part in some of the Adeyfield School Music events listed below. Please complete the reply slip at the end of the letter for events that are relevant to your child.

### **Bandtime and Project Play Performance Workshop: Wednesday 7 March 12.30pm –3.00pm**

This is a Performance Workshop for all students in Key stages 2 and 3 who participate in Bandtime or Project Play. Students will meet together and rehearse a collection of pieces of music throughout the workshop. Year 9 Bandtime students will be asked to be music leaders for the day and support younger players. The event will be hosted by Leverstock Green School and our students will be taken and collected by school minibus. Your child will require a packed lunch which can be eaten in the canteen between 12.10pm and 12.25pm. We will then travel to Leverstock Green School. Your child will need to wear their full school uniform for the workshop.
