Dear Parent or Carer

As we approach the end of the first full term I would like to take this opportunity to thank you all for your continued support of both the school and your son/daughter.

We are currently in the process of reviewing our school uniform provider. As a result, Price & Buckland are no longer supplying the school blazer or skirts. If, in the meantime, replacements are required, please purchase a plain black blazer and a black knee length tailored skirt. These can be purchased from most high street uniform providers or online through Stevensons Uniform Suppliers (01727 815700) stalbansbranch@stevensons.co.uk.

In addition, our PE kit supplier is also being reviewed. Peter Spivey will cease supplying our PE kit once stocks have run out. As a consequence, if replacement PE kit is required, please purchase a plain black t-shirt, black shorts and black socks.

The CAS faculty would also like to remind students that coats are not permitted to be worn during PE lessons. Students are to wear a plain black sweat shirt. If leggings are worn (winter time only) they must be with shorts.

I have also attached the school uniform policy (slightly revised) to reinforce our expectations. The intention of this is to avoid any unnecessary expenditure and issues with students returning to school after Christmas not dressed correctly, appropriately and in accordance with school uniform policy. I politely remind you that hoodies are not a suitable alternative to coats (particularly given Britain's wet weather) and should never be worn to school. Students arriving at school in hoodies will have them confiscated and placed in Student Services where they can be collected at the end of the school day. Coats should be worn and need to be dark in colour.

Can I also remind you that false or acrylic nails/colours are not allowed. Should students return to school with them after the Christmas festivities they will have to be removed.

Please read the attached carefully as a zero tolerance approach will be adhered to. High standards of uniform, behaviour, being properly equipped and attending regularly helps to ensure that your son/daughter has the opportunity to '*learn without limits*'.
