Dear Parent or Carer

As we approach the end of the first half term I would like to thank you all for your continued support of both the school and your son/daughter. Hopefully, you are beginning to see the rapid rate of change at Adeyfield and have noticed significant improvements.

Adeyfield School is now a much safer place to be through the addition of secure fencing, CCTV and an entrance pod. All have been installed to ensure maximum security, which sadly in the 21st Century is something that is a necessity. In addition, the implementation of Classcharts has had a very positive impact on behaviour and attendance and enables you as parents to keep track of your son/daughters home learning and behaviour profile. The quality of teaching has also had an intense focus resulting in significant improvements reflected by the fantastic examination results achieved in 2018 putting us in line with the National Average.

I have also attached the school uniform policy to reinforce our expectations. The intention of this is to avoid any unnecessary expenditure as we move into the winter months and issues with students' returning to school after half term not dressed correctly, appropriately and in accordance with school uniform policy. I will also add a polite reminder that hoodies are not a suitable alternative to coats (particularly given Britain's wet weather) and should never be worn to school. Students arriving at school in Hoodies will have them confiscated and placed in Student Services where they can be collected at the end of the school day. Coats should be worn and need to be dark in colour. If there are any issues financially please speak to either myself, Miss Walker or your son/daughters head of year where as a school we will do all we can to support.

Please read the attached carefully as a zero tolerance approach will be adhered to, high standards of uniform, behaviour, being properly equipped and attending regularly helps to ensure that your son/daughter has the opportunity to *'learn without limits'*.
