Adeyfield School Uniform Policy

Item	Uniform Expectation
Trousers	Smart, tailored, plain black trousers of waist height and ankle length.
	No jeans, denims, chinos, cords, combats, leggings, hipsters, skinny fit, recent fashion trends or other casual trouser. No trousers with accessories including leg pockets, studs, zips or any other decorative design are to be worn.
	Black socks only.
Skirts	Black knee length tailored skirt (bought from Price & Buckland only) No other styles of skirt are to be worn and must be of an acceptable length.
	Tights must be plain black or nude. Black ankle socks only.
Blazer	Black blazer (bought from Price & Buckland only)
	Sleeves rolled down
Shirts	Plain white shirt (top button fastened)
51 : 11 1	No other decoration, studs, zips etc to be on the shirt.
Plain black	Plain black v-neck sweater (waist length) in winter time only. (Must be worn with a
'V' neck	blazer).
sweater or	No oversized jumpers, round neck sweaters, or hooded sweatshirts.

Ties	The tie must be worn smartly, with the top button of the shirt fastened.
Shoes	Black leather enclosed shoes. NO trainers, (including plain black leather trainers!) boots, canvas or fabric footwear e.g. UGG boots, deck/boating shoes and plimsolls must not be worn.
Coats	Coats are not to be worn inside the school building after leaving morning registration. This also includes scarves and hats. Dark coats and dark scarves and hats. No denim, no leather.
Jewellery	Students are permitted to wear a wrist watch and one small stud earring in each ear. NO other jewellery is allowed. For PE and technology all jewellery must be removed. NO FACIAL PIERCINGS ARE ALLOWED. No visible tattoos. No tongue piercings.
Hair	Hairstyles should be should be neat, tidy and smart.
	No hairstyles with unnatural colours.
	No mohican/mohawk cuts.
	No tram lines and shaven patterns.
Make-Up &	Only a discreet amount of make-up may be worn and fingernails should be appropriate to
Fingernails	enable students to participate in all activities.
	No extreme make-up. Absolutely no false or acrylic nails/colours.

All decisions made about uniform will be at the discretion of the Headteacher. Flagrant disregard for the uniform code will result in the following sanctions:

- Being asked to go home and get in to the right uniform (we will inform you of this).
- Internal isolation.
- Lunchtime or breaktime detention. Continuous disregard for the code will ultimately be seen as defiance and could result in exclusion.
