At Adeyfield School we place an emphasis on pride in our community. A visible indication of this is in the standard of our students' uniform.

The following letter clearly highlights our expectations of school uniform and clarifies further the actions that will be taken should they arrive incorrectly dressed for school.

If a student arrives at school missing an item of uniform with a note from a parent/carer advising the school of the missing item and a timescale for its replacement, a note will be issued for a maximum of two weeks. We maintain a store of spare items in the pastoral office which we allow students to borrow to enable them to access their full education, whilst the situation is rectified. **We do not permit students to circulate in the body of the school if they are not in full uniform.**

If a student arrives at school missing an item of uniform and without a note from a parent/carer then the student will be asked to remain in the Pastoral Office until the parent/carer can be contacted and the item of uniform brought into school or permission granted that they return home to collect the correct/missing item(s). Alternatively changing into a school replacement is an option.

If we are unable to contact a parent, or a student has more than one piece of uniform which is inappropriate they will be detained by the Pastoral team and will not go into lessons.

Attached to this letter are the full expectations of our school uniform policy. If you have any further questions or queries please do not hesitate to contact either myself or a member of the Pastoral Team.

Should you have any concerns or disagreements, please indicate on the slip below and return the slip to Student Services.

If you are in agreement with the above there is no requirement to return the reply slip.

Adeyfield School Uniform Policy

Item	Uniform Expectation
Trousers	<p>Smart, tailored, plain black trousers of waist height and ankle length.</p> <p>No jeans, denims, chinos, cords, combats, leggings, hipsters, skinny fit, recent fashion trends or other casual trouser. No trousers with accessories including leg pockets, studs, zips or any other decorative design are to be worn.</p>
Skirts	<p>Black knee length tailored skirt – no lycra or tight fitted.</p> <p>No other styles of skirt are to be worn.</p>
Blazer	<p>Black blazer (bought from Price & Buckland only) Sleeves rolled down</p>
Shirts	<p>Plain white shirt (top button fastened)</p> <p>No other decoration, studs, zips etc to be on the shirt.</p>
Plain black 'V' neck sweater or cardigan (optional)	<p>Plain black v-neck sweater or cardigan (waist length) in winter time only. (Must be worn with a blazer).</p> <p>No oversized jumpers or cardigans, round neck sweaters, or hooded sweatshirts.</p>
Ties	<p>The tie must be worn smartly, with the top button of the shirt fastened.</p>
Shoes	<p>Black leather enclosed shoes.</p> <p>NO trainers, (including plain black leather trainers!) boots, canvas or fabric footwear e.g. UGG boots, deck/boating shoes and plimsolls must not be worn).</p>
Coats	<p>Coats are not to be worn inside the school building after leaving morning registration. This also includes scarves and hats.</p>
Jewellery	<p>Students are permitted to wear a wrist watch and one small earring in each ear.</p> <p>NO other jewellery is allowed. For PE and technology all jewellery must be removed.</p> <p>NO FACIAL PIERCINGS ARE ALLOWED.</p>
Hair	<p>Hairstyles should reflect the school's core value of "Look Smart". The student forum reviewed and amended this to; hairstyles should be neat, tidy and smart.</p> <p>No hairstyles with unnatural colours.</p> <p>No mohican/mohawk cuts.</p> <p>No tram lines and shaven patterns.</p>
Make-Up & Fingernails	<p>Only a discreet amount of make-up may be worn and fingernails should be appropriate to enable students to participate in all activities.</p> <p>No false/acrylic nails.</p>
