As part of our A Level Politics course we have arranged for students to visit the YouGov Offices and spend some time with the Political Research Department. This is a really exciting opportunity to look at Politics in action. Students will be accompanied by myself and Mr Cline.

Students should meet us at Hemel Hempstead train station by 8:45am on Friday 19 January at the main entrance. We will take the train and underground to the YouGov offices in Central London. We aim to arrive at their offices by 11am.

Students will then have a tour of the offices, have a chance to speak with researchers and learn more about their roles and route ways into the sector. We anticipate finishing at YouGov at around 1pm.

After leaving YouGov there will be an opportunity for the group to have lunch. Students should either bring a packed lunch or money to purchase food in London. We also hope to have some time to visit Parliament Square and surrounding prominent places of interest before returning to Hemel Hempstead station by 3:30pm.

Students should be in 'Business Dress'. This constitutes:

For Boys – Suit / Smart Trousers, Shirt, Tie, Shoes

For Girls – Skirt or Dress (Knee-length at least), Blouse/Shirt, Shoes

Any student not in appropriate business dress will not be allowed to attend.
