## Uniform from September 2014

Following discussions with students, parents and staff we are changing the skirts that can be worn. From September 2014 only skirts purchased through the School's Uniform supplier **Price & Buckland** can be worn.

This has been discussed through the Staff, Student and Parent Forums and the consensus of opinion is that the school should clearly state the length of skirt to be worn. From September girls should wear a skirt to the knee and our uniform supplier has two styles of skirt available in different lengths. Prices start at £12 and go up to a maximum of £15. To make this as simple as possible we have a selection of sample skirts available for students to try on at Student Services.

The feedback from the students is that they like the look and feel of the new skirts and are looking forward to there being a clear policy of what is to be worn in September.

I would take this opportunity to remind you that for all students who wear trousers, these must be tailored and not in any way resemble jeans, leggings or skinny fit trousers.
