## Adeyfield Sixth Formers reach for the Skies in Norfolk

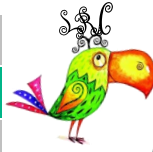

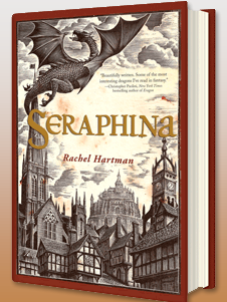
