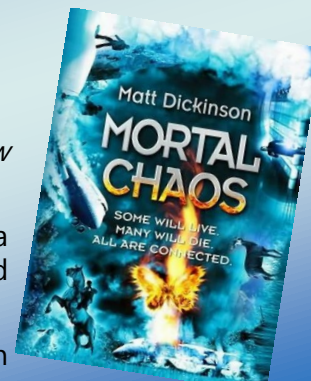
Book of the Week...
